## WARNING LIGHTS



- Red lights - Danger. Stop immediately and refer to owner's manual.
  - Amber lights - System malfunction. Proceed with caution. Have vehicle checked by a technician immediately.
  - Green lights - Normal operation or function engaged.
- All lights appear for a system check when starting up.**

## WIPER MAINTENANCE



- Check windscreen washer levels regularly.
  - Use washer fluid when re-filling reservoir
  - Replace wipers if they smear, streak, chatter or squeak.
    - Check for splits to rubber.
    - Replace just rubber or entire blade.
- Keep headlights clean to improve visibility and reduce glare.**

## SAVING FUEL



- Remove unnecessary weight from the boot.
  - Ensure car's tyres are correctly inflated.
  - Close windows and sunroof where possible.
  - Choose routes where you can maintain a constant speed rather than stop start in traffic.
  - Remove roof bars and bike holders if not needed.
- Drive smoothly - plan steady braking and accelerating.**

## DRIVING WITHIN THE EU



- Always carry important documents with you (Registration document, insurance, passport).
  - Carry a warning triangle, reflective jackets, first aid kit.
  - Keep replacement headlamp bulbs in your boot.
  - Drive on the left in the UK, Channel Islands, Ireland, Malta.
- Make sure you get to know the driving laws in the country you are visiting.**
